

Year 7 Catch – Up Funding

What Is It For?

This funding is to provide additional teaching support to pupils who have not reached level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of year 6. The funding is used to ensure that the identified pupils catch up as quickly as possible.

Financial Year 2015/16

We received £10,500 funding in March 2016 for those pupils not achieving a level 4 in either English or Mathematics.

Financial Year 2016/17

It is anticipated that we will receive £8,500 funding for this academic year. We intend to continue our use of the accelerated reader programme for the coming year as this has proven to be successful in encouraging participation in reading and in boosting reading ages. We have now extended the programme to year 8 pupils.

In addition to the above programme, we will be offering one to one targeted support through the use of an English HLTA, and additional learning resource materials.
